E-learning



We strive to explore up-to-date teaching methods. With more e-resources and continuous renovation of facilities, we have fostered a positive e-learning environment.

E-learning encourages students' participation in lessons, arouses their interests and facilitates student's learning. With e-learning tools, we conduct interactive activities in class and are able to provide instant feedback.

Shooting for the Stars



In order to enhance S6 students' confidence in taking the HKDSE Exam, we have an after-school support programme, 'Shooting for the Stars', which aims to equip them with exam techniques. A self-study room is open for them to use after school every day.

The students can not only prepare for the exam in a comfortable and quiet learning environment, but they can also use the learning tools and materials available in the room, such as iPads and past exam papers. In addition, subject teachers set learning goals together with the participating students, review their learning progress regularly and support them with words of encouragement.

Besides, the teachers give them specific advice and tips on how to tackle questions tactfully so as to reach their ultimate goal – passing the exam with flying colours.

Xiefengxuan



The Chinese Culture Room – Xiefengxuan – was proudly set up by the Chinese Department and Chinese History Department to promote the beauty of Chinese culture.

Confucius said, 'If you do not learn the Odes, you will not be fit to converse with'. 'Feng ya', meaning elegance in English, is related to poetry and 'feng' is the major component of the Classic of Poetry. Xiefengxuan, where 'xie', one of the characters in Concordia's Chinese name in short, combines with 'feng' in the name, engages our students in various learning activities related to Chinese history.

The room's decor and furniture are all in the traditional Chinese style, from the curtains with Chinese paintings to other decorating elements including the ancient reading desks, wooden chairs and traditional book cabinets.

We believe that our students will be knowledgeable and achieve excellence in Chinese culture and history – the aim of setting up Xiefengxuan.

STEM Education



Implemented in a cross-curriculum and integrated manner, our STEM education is carried out in three tiers: "Learning STEM inside the classroom", "Exploring STEM outside the classroom", "Enhancement and remedial programmes". ASTEM-related programme of RTHK also interviewed us in recognition of this approach.

We joined the Education Bureau's School-based Curriculum Development Support Programme, focusing on assessment for learning and integrating STEM across different curricula. We carry out a variety of cross-curricula STEM projects.

Last but not least, we encourage students to partake in various inter-school competitions. In the METOMICS STEM Competition 2021 organised by the Hong Kong Education Development Association, our representatives won the overall champions.

Concordia Second Classroom



The Concordia Second Classroom aims to provide extra help for junior form students to consolidate their foundations in the core subjects. In small groups, they learn interactively in enhancement and remedial classes.

We run the programme jointly with the Abiding Grace Church, whose volunteers assist the tutors, our outstanding graduates. Being good role models, these friendly alumni can inspire the current Concordians to pursue academic success and continue to pass on this long-established tradition.

Business Curriculum



Student motivation and knowledge application are the keys to arousing their learning interest. In Business, Accounting and Financial Studies, our belief is 'Pleasurable and Effective Learning with Solid Foundation'. We adopt the 'learning by doing' strategy extensively in our teaching and learning. Through active participation in learning activities, our students find that learning is fun and retain knowledge memorably. Exchange Tours



As the saying goes, 'He that travels far knows much'. We are dedicated to offering exchange programmes to mainland China and overseas countries to broaden both our students and teachers' horizons.

Through experiential learning, Concordians can raise awareness of their country's economy, culture and social conditions. The exchange programmes are also effective to improve their confidence and communication techniques.

Multi-Cultural Campus

In order to create an optimal English learning environment, not only do we have a Native English Teacher (NET), but we also make good use of resources inside and outside the classroom to boost students' learning motivation and stimulate their interest in learning.

Exchange with Students of Hong Kong International School (HKIS)

Through regular meetings with HKIS's students, our students can learn more different cultures. Besides, we make good use of the resources in the community to carry out extra-curricular activities, like Crossword's 'Struggle for survival' simulation, which deepens their understanding of different cultures.

U.S. Missionaries

Caring for students' spiritual needs and building a multi-cultural campus are always our priorities. We therefore provide students with opportunities to have exchanges with long-term or short-term missionaries and volunteers from different parts of the world to experience other cultures, immersing them in an English speaking environment, understand the Gospel and learn English. Through sharing with our long-term school missionary from the U.S., students can learn the importance of gratitude and enhance their English communication skills.

Visits of International Teams

Regular visits of international teams to school, we organise a variety of English extra-curricular activities, such as the Watoto Children's Choir's Asia Concert Tour.

American Gospel and Cultural Exchange Tour

We have a close partnership with The American Lutheran Church (TALC). During the post-exam period in June and July, in the American Gospel and Cultural Exchange Tour, Concordians participated in the local churches' community services in which they promoted Christ's teachings of loving others and served others. This also provided them with a precious opportunity to have a taste of American culture and lifestyle, broaden their horizons and improve their English proficiency through real-life experiences.

International Youth Organisations

We work with different youth organisations, such as Youth with A Mission (YWAM), Young Life (YL) and Youth For Christ (YFC). Through meaningful activities, our students are nurtured with the utmost care so that their lives are filled with hope and comfort.

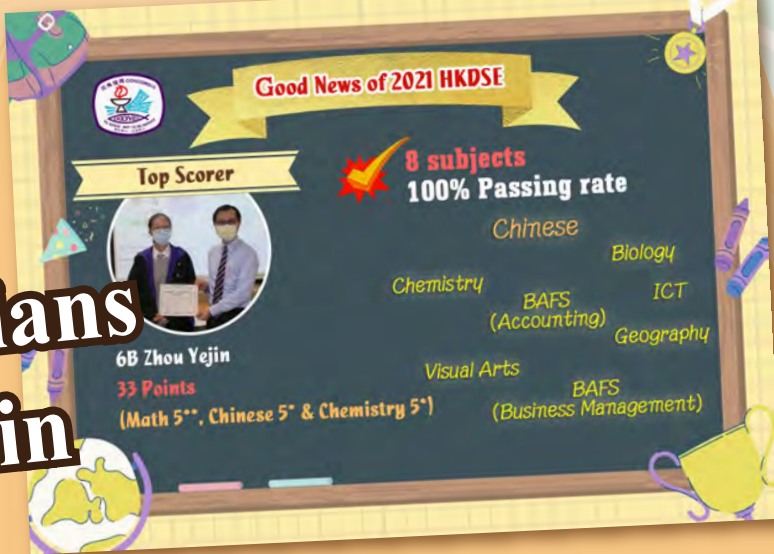

Students have encountered unprecedented difficulties and challenges since the outbreak of COVID-19. Yet, with the persistent efforts from our teachers and students, S6 students achieved outstanding performances in the 2021 HKDSE Exam. A total of 8 subjects reached a passing rate of 100%, including Chinese, Chemistry, Geography, Biology, ICT, BAFS (Accounting), BAFS (Business Management) and Visual Arts. Zhou Yeqin from Class 6B was our top achiever this year with her best 5 subjects scoring 33 points! She received a 5** in Mathematics and 5* in both Chinese and Chemistry. She was successfully admitted to the Bachelor of Chinese Medicine at the University of Hong Kong, aiming to contribute to society after her study.
