Dear Parents / Guardians,

The important issues in December 2022 and January 2023 are summarised below. Please read and sign the reply slip through eClass Parents App on or before 29th November 2022 (Tuesday).

1. School Picnic

According to the school calendar, the school picnic will be held on 2nd December (Friday). Please refer to Notice to Parents No. 2223/067 for more details.

2. Change into Winter School Uniform

All students will have to get changed into winter school uniform starting from 5th December (Monday).

3. Parents' Day

Parents' Day for the 1st Term will take place on 10th December (Saturday) from 12:15 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. and report cards for the 1st Term will be issued. "S6 Career Talk cum Parent-Teacher Association Annual General Meeting" for S6 students and their parents will be held from 2:30 p.m. to 3:45 p.m. on the same day. All students and parents are welcome to attend. If parents cannot turn up, please contact the class teacher and reschedule the appointment. 4. Christmas Gospel Activities

As December is approaching, Christmas commemorating the birth of Jesus Christ is just around the corner.

It is the Gospel Week between 15th and 21st December. Spiritual Education Department will organise various Gospel activities such as Student Fellowship and Afternoon Music Show. Students are welcome to join.

Christmas worship is held on 21st December. Details are as follows:

Roll Call: 8:45 a.m.

Time to Assemble: 9:00 a.m. (classrooms)

Worship: 9:15 a.m. - 10:45a.m.

Class Party: 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. (up to the decision of individual class)

5. Supplementary classes during Christmas Holidays and Lunar New Year Holidays

Christmas and New Year Holidays will fall between 22nd December 2022 and 2nd January 2023 and Lunar New Year Holidays will fall between 23rd and 31st January 2023. During the holidays supplementary classes are arranged for certain classes during the holidays. (A notice to parents will be distributed to the corresponding classes before the holidays.)

Students taking the subjects concerned have to attend the supplementary classes at school in school uniform. Students who are absent from the supplementary classes have to submit a parent's letter and a medical certificate when normal classes resume. Unauthorized absence will be regarded as truancy.

6. Sports Day

Our Sports Day is going to be held in Siu Sai Wan Sports Ground. Details are as follows:

According to the school calendar, 13th January, the day following the Sports Day is a holiday for all students.

Points to note:

1. Students should wear proper school PE uniform and bring along their student card for verification purposes.
2. Except being exempted under the Law, all visitors are required to scan the LeaveHomeSafe QR code and present their vaccination requirement of the Vaccine Pass / COVID-19 Vaccination Medical Exemption Certificate with a QR code for scanning upon entry.
3. Except being exempted under the Law, all visitors are required to fulfil the "Vaccine Pass" (Blue Code) requirement when entering Sports Ground.
4. Students who do not qualify for the Vaccine Pass will be arranged for on-campus activities, details to be announced.
5. When entering the stadium, students are required to sit according to their classes and take attendance under the class teacher's instruction. Latecomers are subject to disciplinary actions in accordance with those in normal school days.
6. Students must stay in the stadium. Early leave due to personal reasons can only be made with teacher's permission in advance.
7. Students' participation in the event is highly encouraged. No toys, chess, card games, game players or earphones are permitted. Students must switch off their mobile phones and beware of their own belongings at all times.
8. Students are not allowed to yell, run or stand on the passage, or leave their seats without permission. They are

- obliged to keep the stadium clean.
9. Students should follow the instructions given by teachers or school prefects.
 10. After finishing the competition, students must return to the spectator stand and be seated.
 11. If students feel unwell, they should inform teachers or school prefects immediately.
 12. When the event ends, students should leave the stadium according to teachers' instructions.

Reminders on Taking Leaves

1. Sports day is a part of the school curriculum. Every student must attend the event. Absence without valid reasons will be considered as truancy.
2. The School encourage students to participate in the competition, but it would be voluntary for students to join.
3. Students applying for sick leave must submit a parent's letter and a medical certificate to the class teacher on the next school day (i.e. 16th January 2023).
4. Students applying for casual leave must notify in writing in advance, with reasons stated clearly. Normally approval is granted only in case of matters of great importance (e.g. weddings or funerals of family members).

7. CLSNP V-show cum Dress Casual Day

Our annual CLSNP Variety Show organised by the Student Union will take place at 9:00 a.m. - 10:45 a.m. on 20th January 2023. It is also our Dress Casual Day. Students who donate \$10 can wear their casual outfit to school. Students need to arrive school on or before 8:40 a.m.

8. Open Day and S1 Admission

Please be advised that there will be an Open Day on 17th December 2022 and you are welcome to join the event. Details can be found on the poster attached to this notice.

Application for S1 will be open from 3rd January to 17th January 2023. It is most appreciated if you can recommend our school to your family and relatives. Application forms are available in the general office and the school website. Application should be made with the completed application form and the following documents:

- (1) Originals and copies of P5 and P6 report cards;
- (2) Originals and copies of identity documents;
- (3) A recent photo (with the applicant's name on the back)

Notification will be made by the Education Bureau to successful applicants through their current primary schools on 11th July 2023 according to "S1 Discretionary Place" system.
