Remarks:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Please read the attached information.2. On the day of departure, students must carry the “ID card”, “Home Return Permit”, and other required documents. Students are required to provide the copies of the related document <u>by 28th February 2026</u>.3. Students may wear appropriate casual attire. To show respect for the occasion, please refrain from wearing tank tops, shorts, or flip-flops.4. Should a student request to withdraw before departure, <u>they shall be responsible for any additional costs incurred due to the withdrawal. Furthermore, the school may revoke the student's subsidy; in such cases, the student will be required to pay the full tour fee in addition to any relevant withdrawal penalties. Only under exceptional circumstances such as illness (supported by valid medical certificate) or other major unforeseen incidents that prevent the student from joining the trip, will the school consider maintaining the subsidy for the student.</u>5. Those who are unable to make the trip due to illness on the day of the activity must contact the school office and submit the <u>leave letter with valid medical certificate</u> to the teacher in charge when return to school.		

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| | <p>6. According to the guidelines from the Education Bureau, the top priority for the Bureau and schools is the safety and health of students. In principle, students are not required to purchase additional main meals at their own expense due to insufficient food portions. <u>Considering potential hygiene risks and actual needs, students should not use food delivery platforms to purchase food or drinks during the trip.</u> If students are found to use food delivery platforms to buy food or drinks, the school will confiscate the relevant items without returning them and will take appropriate disciplinary action.</p> <p>7. According to the guidelines from the Education Bureau, <u>male and female students cannot share the same room.</u> In addition, after completing the examination activities and checking into the hotel each day, students should try to stay in their rooms to rest or organize what they have learned that day; <u>they should not leave the hotel without permission, and the use of recreational facilities within the hotel</u> (such as gyms or recreation rooms) is not recommended to avoid insufficient rest affecting the next day's activities.</p> <p>8. The organizing institution has purchased group comprehensive travel insurance for accompanying teachers and students. The insurance plan is Taiping Comprehensive Travel Insurance Scheme – China Plan from China Taiping Insurance (HK) Company Limited. For more details, please refer to https://shorturl.at/2pjzk. Students may purchase additional travel insurance based on individual needs for extra protection.</p> <p>9. The school will hold a briefing session in late February, where more detailed information and itinerary will be provided.</p> |
