To show respect for the occasion, please refrain from wearing tank tops, shorts, or flip-flops.</li> <li>3. Students may purchase additional travel insurance based on individual needs for extra protection.</li> <li>4. On the day of departure, students must carry the “ID card”, “Home Return Permit” and other required documents. Students who fail to provide valid documents for travel to Mainland China will not be permitted to participate in this study tour.</li> <li>5. This activity is subsidized by the Funding Scheme for Youth Exchange in the Mainland of the Home and Youth Affairs Bureau (HYAB). All participating students are required to register as HKYouth+ members.</li> <li>6. Should a student request to withdraw before departure, they shall be responsible for any additional costs incurred due to the withdrawal. Furthermore, the organizing institution may revoke the student's subsidy; in such cases, the student will be required to pay the full tour fee in addition to any relevant withdrawal penalties. Only under exceptional circumstances such as illness (supported by valid medical certificate) or other major unforeseen incidents that prevent the student from joining the trip, will the organizing institution consider maintaining the subsidy for the student.</li> <li>7. Students should bring their own medication if necessary. If student is unable to attend the trip due to illness on the day, please contact Ms. Chan Wing Yan Glad ( ).
